◆ We use **he** for a man or a boy.



man - **he**



boy - **he**

◆ We use **she** for a woman or a girl.



woman - **she**



girl - **she**

◆ We use **it** for a thing or an animal when we do not know its sex.



car - **it**



tiger - **it**

When we talk about our pets or animals whose sex we know we can use **he** or **she**.

◆ In the plural we use **they** for people, animals, plants and things.



two girls - **they**



roses - **they**
